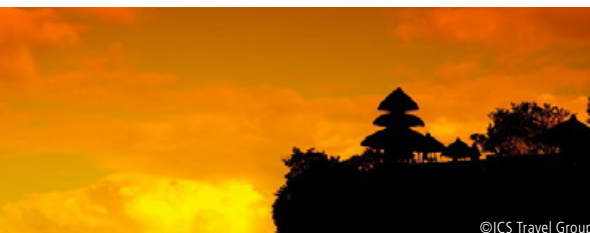

Bali

Best Time to Travel

Bali lies just 8 degrees south of the equator, and has a fairly even climate all year round. Day time temperatures at the beach range from 70 – 90 degrees F. Ubud, in the mountains, is cooler. The wet season is from October through April, with December to March being prone to monsoons. May through September are dry and popular months to visit. As this period is generally wet in north Asia, Bali makes an excellent choice for US summer holiday travel.



A perfect week in Bali

The typical Bali itinerary includes time in Ubud and time at the beach. Which beach you choose depends on whether you prefer peace and quiet, or a faster pace. This itinerary includes Seminyak, which is considered to be the best all round choice. Close enough to Kuta so you can drop in and check it out, far enough away to seem like another world. Time permitting an extension to the Gilis or Lombok is highly recommended.

Itinerary

Day 1 : Arrive Bali

Airport transfer to your accommodation.

Day 2 : Seminyak Beach

Day tour of the historical and cultural highlights of Bali. Gunung Kawi Tegallalang, an 11th century temple carved into a cliff face; the Kerta Gosa Royal Court House; Besakih Temple. (B,L)

Day 3 : Seminyak Beach

Afternoon tour to the wild southern beaches. Enjoy a performance of the Ramayana-inspired Kecak dance with the majestic Uluwatu temple and sunset as its background, followed by a seafood dinner. (B,D)

Day 4 : Seminyak Beach

At leisure to enjoy the beach. (B)

Day 5 : Ubud

Drive to the mountains and Ubud. Afternoon lunch and Ubud highlights tour including Mas wood carving artisans village, Ubud Palace and an art market. (B, L)

Day 6 : Ubud

At leisure to enjoy Ubud. (B)

Day 7 : Depart

You will be transferred to the airport for your onward flight. (B)
